● **No dogs**
We do not allow dogs on this nature reserve. Research has shown that even just the presence of dogs disturbs wildlife. If you wish to walk your dog, please use the path to the beach.

● **Entry and car parking**
There is no entry fee because we want to encourage everyone to learn about nature - but there is a car parking charge of £2 per day for all day parking (annual permits available). This helps us maintain all our facilities and the reserve. Cycle racks are also provided.

● **Opening hours**
The Wildlife Discovery Centre and Nature Reserve is open daily throughout the year (except Christmas Day). Please check the Northumberland Wildlife Trust website for our opening hours.

● **Things you need to know...**
We lock the car park at night so do make sure you don't leave it too late to get your car.
